

Student Fee Information:

Who decides how my student fees are allocated?

At the beginning of spring semester every year, the UVUSA Student Council holds Student Fee Hearings. Any department or organization on campus who currently receives funding from student fees or would like to receive funding from student fees must come present to the Student Council. The presentations are reports on how the money has been spent; requests for continued funding or increases, as needed; and, most importantly, how these expenditures benefit the student body. These meetings are open to the public, and Student Council encourages student participation. Dates for the 2017-2018 Student Fee Hearings will take place from late January through February, between 1-3pm on Thursdays. Specific dates will be announced after the New Year.

After the conclusion of the Student Fee Hearings, the UVUSA Executive Council (Student Body President and the Vice Presidents) prepare a Student Fee Proposal. The proposal is presented to, reviewed and voted on by Student Council, and then sent to UVU's President's Council. Once passed by both of these entities, it is sent to the UVU Board of Trustees, and finally to the Utah Board of Regents for approval.
